AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION  
AND CONTROL OF THE SALE OF LIQUOR BY LICENSING

No. 16

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

That the Ordinance previously passed by this Board, shall be amended, with respect to the licensing of Taverns wherein liquor is offered for sale and is sold, within the limits of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as to the clause setting for the license fee to be charged for such operation, offering for sale, and selling in the following manner:

The license fee shall hereinafter be at the rate of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars per annum, to be paid semi-annually in installments of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars each, in advance.

That the Ordinance previously passed by this Board with respect to the within subject shall remain, in all other respects except the matters herein amended, the same as previously passed.
