BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT the office of POLICE MAGISTRATE be and the same is
hereby created in conformance with the STATUTES OF THE
STATE OF ILLINOIS relating to municipalities and their
powers to create such OFFICE.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
after its passage and due publication, as required by law.
