ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE,
PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, REGULATING
OFFENSIVE AND UNWHOLESOME BUSINESSES
AND ESTABLISHMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue:

SECTION 1. No offensive or unwholesome business or establishment shall be maintained, conducted or carried on within the Village of Bellevue or within the distance of One (1) mile beyond the municipal limits thereof, nor shall any business or establishment be maintained, conducted or carried on in an offensive or unwholesome manner or way within the areas aforesaid, nor in any way within the areas aforesaid, which shall be or become unwholesome or offensive to any person.

SECTION 2. All persons, firms and corporations, who shall, directly or indirectly, maintain, carry on, engage in or conduct or cause to be maintained, carried on or conducted, or who shall be in charge, possession or control of any business or establishment, or any part thereof in violation of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each such violation of this Ordinance. Each day that any such person, firm or corporation shall violate this Ordinance shall be considered to be a separate offense and shall be punishable accordingly.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication or posting as required by Law.
