

ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE,
PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, REGULATING
THE LOCATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS
AND SIDEWALKS AND THE LOCATION OF
PUBLIC UTILITY POLES AND PIPES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue:

SECTION 1. CURB LINES: Curblines of the public streets within the Village of Bellevue are hereby fixed and located at a distance of Ten (10) feet from the nearest boundary line of the right of way in which said curb line may be located, except that curb lines on Oak Vue Drive and Hi-Way Court are hereby fixed and located at a distance of Six (6) feet from the nearest boundary line of the right of way in which said curb line may be located. All curbs of every kind hereafter constructed shall be located and constructed in such a manner that the outside edge of such curb nearest the center of the right of way of the public street in which the same may be located shall correspond with the curb lines herein above fixed and located by this Section 1 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. SIDEWALK LINES: All public sidewalks hereafter constructed on any public right of way for street purposes within the Village of Bellevue shall be located and constructed in such a manner and at such a place that the inside edge thereof, nearest the boundary line of the right of way in which the same may be located, shall be One and One-half (1½) feet from such boundary line. All public sidewalks hereafter constructed within any right of way for public highway purposes within the Village of Bellevue shall be Four (4) feet in width, ~~except sidewalks constructed within the rights of way upon which Cross-st., Bellevue Avenue and Airport Road are located shall be six (6) feet in width.~~ This Section shall not apply to private sidewalks connecting private premises with public sidewalks which are subject to the provisions of this Section.

SECTION 3. PERMISSION TO CONSTRUCT PERMANENT SIDEWALKS AND CURBS; No public sidewalk or curb shall be hereafter constructed in such a manner that the same shall be permanent or intended, or deemed, to be permanent unless the person, firm or corporation constructing, causing, intending to construct or controlling the construction of the same shall first file with the Chairman of the Roads and Bridges Committee,

appointed by the President and Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, a true and correct plan and specification of the same showing the location, dimensions, type of construction, grade level and any other details concerning the construction of the same, as may be reasonably required by the said Chairman of the said Roads and Bridges Committee, nor until the said Chairman of the Roads and Bridges Committee shall have given his consent in writing to the construction and location thereof, as specified in any such plan and specification, or in any such plan and specification as amended.

SECTION 4. LOCATION OF PUBLIC UTILITY POLES AND PIPES: All poles and pipes to be used for or in connection with the furnishing of telephone service, electric, gas or other public utility service, except only sewer pipes and water pipes or hydrants which are owned by the Village of Bellevue, shall be located between the curb line, as defined in Section 1 of this Ordinance, and the nearest boundary line of the right of way in which the same may be located and in such a manner and at such a place that the same will not in any wise interfere with the construction of curbs or sidewalks at the locations designated in this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. PENALTIES: Whenever any person, firm or corporation shall be found guilty of placing or locating any curb, sidewalk, poles or pipes in violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance or otherwise convicted of any violation of this Ordinance, such person, firm or corporation so found guilty or convicted shall be fined not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each such offense and each day that any such person, firm or corporation shall violate any provision of this Ordinance as aforesaid shall be deemed a separate offense and shall be punishable accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication or posting as required by Law.
