

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS

ORDINANCE NO. 53

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons under the age of sixteen (16) years to be found upon any street, alley, public square or other public ground or place within the said Village between the hours of 9:00 o'clock P. M. and 6:00 o'clock A. M. who are not accompanied by a parent or legal guardian of such person or by an adult relative of such person of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more or other companion of such person of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more and who cannot give a satisfactory account of the reason why such person is absent from his home.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any parent, legal guardian or other person having the custody of any child under the age of sixteen (16) years to cause, permit, or suffer such child to be found upon any street, alley, public square or other public ground or place within the said Village of Bellevue between the hours of 9:00 o'clock P. M. and 6:00 o'clock A. M. without such child being accompanied by its parent, legal guardian, adult relative of such child of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more or other person of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more and who cannot give a satisfactory account of the reason why such child is absent from its home.

SECTION 3. Whenever any person shall be found guilty of any violation of this ordinance, such person so found guilty on conviction shall be fined not less than \$2, nor more than \$10, for each offense.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and due publication or posting, as required by law.
