ORDINANCE NO. 67 OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE,
PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, DESIGNATING CERTAIN
STREETS AS THROUGH STREETS AND REGULATING TRAFFIC

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees
of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION I: From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to do, perform or commit any of the following acts within the corporate limits of the said Village of Bellevue:

(a) To drive or operate any vehicle on any portion of any street within such street's intersection with any "through street" designated in this Ordinance or designated in any Ordinance passed hereafter, without first stopping such vehicle before entering such portion of such "through street" within its intersection with such other street and without keeping such vehicle stopped until such vehicle may be safely driven across or upon such portion of any "through street" as may be intersected by such other street without danger to pedestrian or vehicular traffic thereon.

(b) To drive or operate any vehicle on any portion of any street within an intersection herein designated as a "stop intersection" or designated in any ordinance hereafter passed as a "stop intersection," without first stopping such vehicle before entering such portion of such street within such intersection and without keeping such vehicle stopped until such vehicle may be safely driven across or upon such portion of such street within such intersection without danger to either pedestrian or vehicular traffic within, or near, or approaching such intersection.

SECTION II: The following streets are hereby designated as "through streets":

(1) ~~Closen Road is hereby designated as a "through street" from Bellevue Avenue to Anna Avenue, except only at the intersection of Closen Road and Main Street.~~

(2) Main Street is hereby designated as a "through street" throughout its entire length, except only at the intersection of Closen Road and Main Street.

(3) Bellevue Avenue is hereby designated as a "through street" from Illinois State Route #116 to Closen Road.

SECTION III: "Stop intersections" are hereby defined to be intersections of public highways located within the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois into which no vehicle shall be driven or operated without full compliance by the driver thereof with Section I(b) of this Ordinance. The following intersections of public streets within the said Village of Bellevue are hereby designated as "stop intersections": *Intersection of Gamma + Cloven Rd.*

(1) The intersection of Cloven Road and Main Street is hereby designated as a "stop intersection." *At time onto Cloven*

SECTION IV: No person shall drive or operate any vehicle into or upon any portion of any "through street" designated in this Ordinance, or designated in any Ordinance passed hereafter, from any private road, lane or other premises adjoining any such "through street" along the right-of-way lines thereof without first stopping such vehicle before entering any portion of such "through street" and without keeping such vehicle stopped until such vehicle may be safely driven across or upon such portion of such "through street" without danger to either pedestrian or vehicular traffic thereon. *Cloven at Gamma*

SECTION V: No person shall operate any vehicle upon the streets or alleys in the Village of Bellevue in a wanton or reckless manner, showing an utter disregard for the safety of others or the property of others under circumstances likely to cause bodily injury or property damage.

SECTION VI: Whenever any person, firm or corporation shall be found guilty of any violation of this Ordinance, such person, firm or corporation so found guilty on conviction shall be fined not less than two Dollars (~~\$2~~) nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10) for each offense.
