ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE STOR-  
ING AND PILING OF MATERIALS ON  
PRIVATE PROPERTY IN A MANNER  
INJURIOUS TO PUBLIC HEALTH

Be it Ordained by the President and the Board of  
Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, as follows:

1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to store,  
pile or cause to be kept upon his premises any materials  
in such a manner as to become a rat harbor and a nuisance  
to the public health of the residents of the Village of  
Bellevue.

2. Any person so storing, piling or causing to be  
kept any materials upon his premises in such manner as to  
become a rat harbor shall be subject to a penalty of Twenty-  
five (\$25.00) Dollars, and a like penalty for every week he  
shall continue the same after the first conviction.

3. This Ordinance shall, after its passage and  
approval, shall be published as provided by the laws of  
the State of Illinois, and shall be in full force and  
effect as provided by law.
