ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 13  
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF  
BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and the Board of Trustees  
of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION I. That Ordinance Number 13 of the Municipal Code  
of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, is hereby  
amended by striking out said sections thereof, and inserting in  
lieu thereof the following new sections:

WEEDS

SECTION II. All weeds which, due to pollination, are a menace  
to health, are hereby declared to be a public nuisance. ?

It shall be unlawful for any person owning, leasing, occupying or  
controlling any plot of ground to permit the growth of such weeds  
thereon.

SECTION III. For every violation of Section II of this  
Ordinance, the person, firm or corporation responsible shall, on  
conviction for the first offense, be punished by a fine of not  
less than ten dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars, and for  
the second and each subsequent offense, not less than twenty-five  
dollars nor more than fifty dollars.

SECTION IV. It shall be the duty of the responsible village  
officials to enforce the provisions of Section II of this Ordinance  
and to notify persons violating the same to cut or destroy  
said weeds within five (5) days from the date of the service of  
such notice, and upon failure of such owner, tenant, or occupant,  
to comply with the said notice, said officials shall proceed to  
have the same cut or destroyed.

SECTION IV. b. In the event that the village is required to  
cut or destroy said weeds, the owner or the premises on which the  
weeds are growing, shall be liable to the Village of Bellevue for  
the expense incurred by the Village of Bellevue in cutting or  
destroying said weeds.

SECTION IV. c. An account of the cost of cutting or destroy-  
ing the weeds on each separate piece or parcel of ground shall be  
maintained and upon completion of the work, a statement shall be  
rendered to the owner of the premises for the cost thereof, and if  
not paid, suit shall be instituted.

SECTION V. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict  
herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage, approval and publication according to  
law.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ANNEXING TERRITORY USED FOR A HIGHWAY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 24, Section 7, subsection 9, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1953, the following described real property is annexed to the Village of Bellevue; Peoria County, Illinois:

A part of Sections 10 and 11 in Township Eight (8) North, Range Seven (7) East of the Fourth Principal meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the center of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 at the westerly limits of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, thence in a northerly direction to the north edge of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8, thence on an easterly direction along and upon the north edge of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 to a point on the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 that is located northeasterly from the center of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 at the easterly limits of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, thence in a westerly direction along the center of the highway known as State Route 116 and 8 to the point of beginning, situate, lying and being in the County of Peoria and State of Illinois.

SECTION 2. It is the intention of this ordinance to annex all of that north half of that highway known as State Route 116 and 8 that lies contiguous to the south half of the highway that is presently incorporated in the Village.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and due recording as required by law.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 113

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE  
PARKING OF VEHICLES ON THE  
PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS  
IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE,  
PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of  
Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION I. Ordinance Number 72 of the Ordinances  
of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, entitled, "An Ordinance  
Regulating the Parking of Cars in the Village of Bellevue,  
Peoria County, Illinois," is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION II. Henceforth, it shall be unlawful to allow  
any passenger automobile, truck, motorbus, tractor, trailer,  
wagon, cart, road scraper, or any combination thereof, or any  
other vehicle of any kind, regardless of its primary or inci-  
dental utility, to be parked on the public streets or highways  
within the confines of the Village of Bellevue for a period  
of more than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours.

SECTION III. Any person, firm or company who shall  
have been found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be  
subject to a fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)  
nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each 24 consecu-  
tive hour violation.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 114-

AN ORDINANCE REESTABLISHING A  
POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE VILLAGE  
OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the President and the Board of  
Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION I. Ordinance Number 107 of the Ordinances of  
the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, entitled "Ordinance Establishing  
a Police Department of the Village," is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION II. There shall be employed by said Village of  
Bellevue, a police force of not more than four (4) officers.

SECTION III. That the President of the Village of  
Bellevue is hereby empowered to hire and dismiss said police  
officers, and that any such appointments shall be confirmed by the  
Board of Trustees.

SECTION IV. That the President of the Village of  
Bellevue may designate one of the Officers appointed as the  
Chief of Police of the Village of Bellevue.

SECTION V. All pay and allowances to Officers appointed  
shall be governed by the rules and regulations promulgated by  
the Public Health and Safety Committee of the Board of Trustees  
of the Village of Bellevue.

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall be effective upon its  
passage and publication or posting as required by law.
