An Ordinance Prohibiting The Owner or Keeper of
Animals from allowing them to
run at large.

Be it ordained by the President and the Board of
Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois,
as follows:

SECTION I. "Whoever shall permit any animal,
including but not limited to, any dog, cat, horse, sheep,
goat, hog, cow, mule, or chicken to run at large or to be
at large within the limits of said Village shall subject
himself to a fine of not less than FIVE AND NO/100 (\$5.00)
DOLLARS and not more than TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$200.00)
DOLLARS for each and every such offense. This Ordinance
is intended to and does include animals of both sexes, and
of any age."

SECTION II. "This Ordinance shall be in full force
and effect from and after its passage and approval as pro-
vided by law."
