ORDINANCE NUMBER 143

An Ordinance to Amend Section II of Ordinance Number 113, "An Ordinance Regulating the Parking of Vehicles On The Public Streets and Highways in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois.

Be it ordained by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION I. That Section II of Ordinance Number One Hundred Thirteen (113), An Ordinance regulating the parking of vehicles on the public streets and highways in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, passed and approved by the President and Board of Trustees of the said Village on May 10, 1955, shall be and the same is, hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"SECTION II. Henceforth, it shall be unlawful to allow any passenger automobile to be parked on the public streets or highways within the confines of the Village of Bellevue for a period of more than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours.

SECTION II (a). Henceforth, it shall be unlawful to allow any commercial vehicles, including, but not limited to trucks, motorbus, tractor, trailer, wagon, cart, road scraper, or any combination thereof, regardless of their or its primary or incidental utility, to be parked on the public streets or highways within the confines of the Village of Bellevue for a period of more than one (1) hour.

SECTION II (b). This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law."
