

ORDINANCE NUMBER

An Ordinance of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois.

Be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois:


Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 24, Section 7-1-8, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1963, the following described real property is hereby annexed to the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois:

Part of the Southeast Quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township Eight (8) North, Range Seven (7) East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, more particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the East line of said Quarter Section, Twenty-four and sixty-two hundredths (24.62) chains South of the Northeast corner of said Quarter Section; running thence West Seven and fifteen hundredths (7.15) chains; thence South and parallel with the East line of said Quarter Section, Eight and seventy-four hundredths (8.74) chains to the center of the public road crossing said Quarter Section; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the center of said road, Seven and thirty-three hundredths (7.33) chains to the intersection of the center line of said road with the East line of said Quarter Section; thence North along the East line of said Quarter Section Eleven and eighteen hundredths (11.18) chains to the place of beginning; being also known and referred to as lot Seven (7) in a subdivision of the Southeast Quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township Eight (8) North, Range Seven (7) East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, as will appear in a plat of said Subdivision filed for record in the Recorder's Office in and for Peoria County, Illinois, and recorded in Plat Book "B", Page 156 EXCEPTING FROM THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PREMISES that part thereof described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Lot Seven (7); thence North Five Hundred Seventy-three and eight tenths (573.8) feet; thence West One Hundred fifty (150) feet; thence South Two Hundred Fifty and thirty-five hundredths (250.35) feet to the center of the public road crossing said Quarter Section; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the center of the road One Hundred seventy (170) feet to the place of beginning, in Peoria County, Illinois.

Section 2. That the Ordinance be in full force and effect after its passage and due recording as required by law.




1. That I am the Chairman of the Board of Directors, Secretary and principal stockholder of SEARCHLIGHT PASS LODGE, INC., a corporation.

Part of the Southeast Quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township Eight (8) North, Range Seven (7) East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, more particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the East line of said Quarter Section, Twenty-four and sixty-two hundredths (24.62) chains South of the Northeast corner of said Quarter Section; running thence West Seven and fifteen hundredths (7.15) chains; thence South and parallel with the East line of said Quarter Section, Eight and seventy-four hundredths (8.74) chains to the center of the public road crossing said Quarter Section; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the center of said road, Seven and thirty-three hundredths (7.33) chains to the intersection of the center line of said road with the East line of said Quarter Section; thence North along the East line of said Quarter Section Eleven and eighteen hundredths (11.18) chains to the place of beginning; being also known and referred to as lot Seven (7) in a subdivision of the Southeast Quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township Eight (8) North, Range Seven (7) East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, as will appear in a plat of said Subdivision filed for record in the Recorder's Office in and for Peoria County, Illinois, and recorded in Plat Book "B", Page 156 EXCEPTING FROM THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PREMISES that part thereof described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Lot Seven (7); thence North Five Hundred Seventy-three and eight tenths (573.8) feet; thence West One Hundred fifty (150) feet; thence South Two Hundred Fifty and thirty-five hundredths (250.35) feet to the center of the public road crossing said Quarter Section; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the center of the road One Hundred seventy (170) feet to the place of beginning, in Peoria County, Illinois.

3. That there are no electors residing on said premises.

4. That SEARCHLIGHT PASS LODGE, INC. is desirous of having the above described real property annexed to the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois.
