

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ALTERATION OF STREET PAVEMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois:

1. No street, alley or driveway openings may be made without permission of the Village Board.
2. Any person, firm or corporation making application for a street, alley or driveway opening shall furnish the Village with a letter of intent from a recognized bonding company to issue a performance bond in the amount of \$1,000.00.
3. Street, alley and driveway openings left overnight must be barricaded and lighted with warning lights.
4. Street, alley or driveway openings may not be over fifty (50) feet long and may not be left open for more than forty-eight (48) hours.
5. All street, alley or driveway openings must be filled with non-settling materials, and the surface in paved roadways must be restored to its original condition within ninety (90) days after the opening is made. Roadways must be maintained in a satisfactory condition at all times until the permanent surface is restored and approved by the Street Committee of the Village's Board of Trustees.
6. Any person, firm or corporation causing any street, alley or driveway to be opened shall be liable to the Village for any and all expenses incurred by the Village in the restoration of water service lines, water mains and appurtenances.
7. Violations shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100.00, nor more than \$500.00 for each offense.
8. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage. Any section or part of this ordinance which shall or may be called invalid, affects that part only, and all sections thereof remaining shall be in full force and effect.
