ORDINANCE NO. 195

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING THE MUNICIPAL TAX FOR THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1969 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1970.

WHEREAS the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, have duly passed and adopted the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the current fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, more than ten days have elapsed since the publication of said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and this Board has now the duty of passing the Annual Tax Levy for the current fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That there is levied and assessed upon all of the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of BELLEVUE, Peoria County, Illinois, for the current fiscal year beginning the 1st day of July, 1969, and ending the 30th day of June, 1970, the total sum of TWENTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO and no/100 DOLLARS (\$20,462.00), said sum being the total of all funds for which this Levy is made, as required to meet the necessary corporate purposes of this Village, as more specifically set forth as follows:

SECTION 2. That the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00), be and the same is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1969, and ending June 30, 1970, upon all taxable property in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, that is the subject of taxation, in addition to all other taxes levied by this Ordinance or any other ordinances, as a PUBLIC BENEFIT TAX, for the purpose of paying a portion of the Public Benefits as may have been assessed or as may be hereafter assessed against the Village for local improvements in this Village, as provided for in Chapter 24, Illinois, Revised Statutes, Article 9-2-39, as amended, and as provided for by Ordinance of the Village of Bellevue heretofore passed.

SECTION 3. That the County Clerk of the County of Peoria, Illinois, is hereby authorized and directed to extend an amount hereby levied against all real and personal property of this Municipality, the same that is subject to taxation, to provide the amount hereby levied, to-wit:

FOR GENERAL CORPORATE PURPOSES - - -	\$ 20,462.00
FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT TAX PURPOSES - - -	500.00
TOTAL AMOUNT LEVIED TO BE RAISED ----	<u>\$ 20,962.00</u>

for the current fiscal year beginning July 1, 1969, and ending June 30, 1970, for necessary corporate purposes.

SECTION 4. That the Village Clerk of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, hereby is directed to file a duly certified copy of this Ordinance in the Office of the County Clerk of Peoria County, Illinois, in the manner and time provided for by Law.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, in the manner provided for by Law.


