

ORDINANCE NO. 204

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CONSISTING OF THE INSTALLATION OF WATER MAINS, VALVES, HYDRANTS AND FITTINGS IN BELLEVUE AVENUE, PLANK ROAD and EISELE DRIVE, IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, TO BE DESIGNATED AS "WATER MAIN EXTENSION - 1969".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That a local improvement be made and it is hereby directed to be made in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, the nature, location, extent, character and description of which said local improvement is as follows:

the installation of an 8" cast iron water main in Bellevue Avenue from Highway Lane to Plank Road, and that an 8" water main, Cast Iron, be installed in Plank Road from Bellevue Avenue to 1000 feet West of Eisele Drive, and that a 6" cast iron water main be installed in Eisele Drive from Plank Road to Lulay Drive, together with necessary valves, fire hydrant sm fittings and appurtenances, forming a connected system of water mains in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, to be designated as "Water Main Extension - 1969".

SECTION 2. PLANS. That the plans and specifications of this improvement, hereto attached and herein referred to, are hereby approved and expressly made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. SUPERVISION. That all of the aforesaid Local Improvement shall be made under the supervision and superintendence and direction of the Board of Local Improvements of this Village.

SECTION 4. RECOMMENDATIONS, ETC., APPROVAL. That the recommendation of the Board of Local Improvements of this Village, are presented to the Board of Trustees, with this Ordinance, and the same are hereby approved.

SECTION 5. ASSESSMENT. That the Improvement herein provided for shall be made and the whole of the cost thereof, including the sum of \$2,172.00, being the estimated cost of Engineering and supervision and the expenses of inspection, and including the further sum of \$1,710.00, being the estimated cost of making the improvement, collecting the assessment and legal fees, and the sum of \$1,710.00, reserve for deficiency and interest, as shown in the Estimate of the Public Engineer, for a total estimated cost of the wntire improvement at \$30,000.00, shall be paid for by special assessment to be levied against the property benefitted to the amount that the same may be legally assessed therefore, or so much as may be equitable to be levied to Public Benefit funds, be and the same

is hereby ordered to be levied, assessed and collected upon all lots, parcels or tracts of land contiguous to and abutting upon or benefitted upon by said improvement in proportion, so far as may be lawful, to the frontage upon said improvement, all in accordance with Article 9 of Chapter 24, Illinois Revised Statutes.

SECTION 6. INSTALLMENTS. That the aggregate amount herein ordered to be assessed, and the amount to be assessed, if any, against this Village, as Public Benefits, shall be divided into ten (10) equal installments, the first of said installments shall include 10% of the assessment, together with fractional amounts, and the aggregate amount of each remaining installment shall be equal in amount and shall be in multiples of \$100. The first installment shall be due and payable on the 2nd day of January, next, after the first voucher issued on account of work done, and the second installment one year thereafter, and so on annually until all installments are paid. And it is hereby the duty of the Board of Local Improvements to file in the Office of the Court in which said assessment is confirmed, a certificate, signed by the secretary, of the date of the first voucher issued and the amount thereof, within 30 days after issuance thereof. All installments shall bear interest from the date of first voucher issued on account of work done, as provided for by Act of the General Assembly, and the interest rate shall be 7% per annum, on said vouchers.

SECTION 7. GENERAL PROVISIONS. All proceedings hereunder, or in this Ordinance provided for, as well as all things provided for herein, are taken pursuant to the terms and provisions of Article 9, Chapter 24, Illinois Revised Statutes, and all amendments thereto.


SECTION 8. BONDS. That for the purpose of anticipating the collection of the second and succeeding installments of said Special Assessment for this Local Improvement, bonds may be issued, payable out of the aforesaid installments, bearing interest at the rate of 7% per annum, payable annually, and said bonds shall be signed by the President of the Board, attested by the Village Clerk and counter-signed, or as provided by said Article 9, Chapter 24, Illinois Revised Statutes; said bonds shall be issued in the sum of \$100.00, or some multiple thereof, and shall be dated and draw interest from date of issuance; said bonds shall be issued in

accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance and as provided for by law.

SECTION 10. REPEAL. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and the due publication thereof, as provided for by law.

R E S O L U T I O N

To the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois.

Whereas, the Board of Local Improvements of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, did hold a public hearing upon the proposed improvement consisting of the installation of water mains in Bellevue Avenue, in Plank Road and in Eisele Avenue, in this Village, and

Whereas, said public hearing was held pursuant to notice sent by first class mail, postage prepaid to all persons to be benefited or on said proposed improvement, more than 15 days prior to the date of the public hearing, and

Whereas, at said public hearing, this Board adopted a resolution to proceed with the project after unanimous approval by all persons attending and that said water main extension be in the manner and form as originally submitted, together with the cost as approved!

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Local Improvements of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois:

SECTION 1. That the water main improvement, as submitted, be approved and that this Board do hereby recommend to the Village Board the making of said improvement;

SECTION 2. That the Board of Local Improvements do submit herewith an ordinance with the recommendation that it be adopted, creating the said local improvement, and also submit herewith the plans, specifications and notices, along with the engineers estimate.

SECTION 3. We hereby highly recommend the approval of the project and adoption of the ordinance and that the local improvement be made.
