ORDINANCE NO. 207

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 205 PERTAINING TO PARKING PROHIBITION IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 205, is hereby amended, and in its place, said Section shall read as follows:

SECTION 3. Any vehicle parked or stopped in violation of the preceding sections may be towed away and impounded by the Police Department, and the owner or person in custody of such vehicle shall be responsible for all costs of towing, the calling of the tow truck if a charge is made for a call, plus a fine, as hereinafter stated:

- a.) For violating Section 1 of this ordinance, the fine shall be \$2.00 for each offense, if paid within 5 days of the issuance of the ticket. Thereafter, the fine shall be \$5.00, if not paid within said 5 days after issuance.
- b.) For violating Section 2 of this Ordinance, the fine shall be not less than \$10.00, nor more than \$200.00, for each offense.

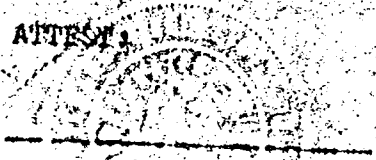
No vehicle shall be removed from being impounded until both the fine and tow are paid, and any person who illegally removed or takes such impounded vehicle shall be fined not less than \$10.00, nor more than \$200.00. All parking fines may be paid at the office of the Village Clerk, together with tow charges, if any.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and the publication thereof, and such publication is hereby ordered to be in pamphlet form and made conveniently available to the public.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts or ordinance in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealed.
