

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance Numbered 45, dated March 26, 1946, is hereby amended as to Section 1 thereof, by adding to said Section 1 of said Ordinance No. 45, the sub-paragraph designated as 1. a.), which shall read as follows:

"1. a.) PACKAGE LIQUOR LICENSE. There is hereby created a package liquor license to be designated and known as a Class "C" license, for the sale of packaged liquor, not to be consumed on the premises. This Class "C" license shall be limited to three (3) in number, and the annual license fee shall be \$300.00, payable quarterly at the rate of \$75.00 each quarter for the quarter in advance. Said Class "C" license holder shall observe all provisions of the ordinances, but opening hours shall be limited to open not sooner than 8:00 o'clock in the morning, and closing by not later than 12 o'clock midnight, each day."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in addition to all other ordinance on the subject and shall be construed therewith, and any conflict with such other ordinance shall, as to such conflict, repeal prior ordinances.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, as provided for by law.
