ORDINANCE NO. 216

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING ALL OF THE WEST HALF OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 8 NORTH, RANGE 7 EAST OF THE FOURTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, TO THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE.

Whereas, the Village Board of the Village of Bellevue, has received a certified copy of an order of the Circuit Court of the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Illinois, at Peoria County, showing that certain proceedings were had pertaining to the annexation of certain territory to this Village, and certifying the final determination of such matter to this Village Board, and

Whereas, it is found by this Board to be a parcel of land contiguous with the existing boundaries of this Village and it is now up to this Village Board to take final action on the question of annexation, and

Whereas, it is deemed to the best interest of this Village, that said tract of parcel be annexed to this Village and made a part hereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the tract or parcel of land being that portion described in the Order of the said Court, as follows:

All of the West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 14, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, in Peoria County, Illinois,

being not in any other municipality, be and the same is hereby annexed to and made a part of the Village of Bellevue and the same is hereby incorporated in and made a part of this Village;

SECTION 2. That upon the taking effect of this ordinance, the Village Clerk shall file a certified copy of this ordinance, together with a copy of the plat thereof, with the Recorder of Deeds and such other official bodies as is required by law.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and the due publication as provided for by law, unless otherwise ordered provided for by law.
