

ORDINANCE NO. 219

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 216 ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND TO THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 216, annexing certain territory to the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, is, by the written request and consent of the sole owner and all electors residing thereon, repealed, said territory being located in Section 14, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, in Peoria County, Illinois, and said territory is hereby disconnected and the annexing ordinance is hereby repealed and set at naught.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided for by law.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
