ORDINANCE NO. 231

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING VEHICLES FROM STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING ON BRIDGES OR TO PROHIBIT PERSONS FROM LOIDERING ON ANY BRIDGE IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AND FIXING A FINE FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to stop, stand or park a vehicle upon any bridge or over-pass or within thirty feet from the end thereof, in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to loider upon any bridge or overpass.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or prop any object from any bridge or over-pass, or to hurl objects therefrom.

SECTION 4. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) nor more than five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and costs.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and due publication thereof, as provided for by law.
