

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A PROPOSAL TO SELL THE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That it is no longer necessary, appropriate of in the best interests of the Village of Bellevue, to continue to operate and maintain its water distribution system.

SECTION 2. That said water distribution system contains certain easements, rights of way and other interests in real estate located and used by the Village of Bellevue to operate and maintain its water distribution system and to lawfully run its transmission lines.

SECTION 3. That said water distribution system contains transmission and distribution mains and appurtenances, fire hydrants, water meters, outside vault meter settings, one hundred thousand gallon elevated storage tank and appurtenances, booster pump station and appurtenances and other equipment and accessories.

SECTION 4. That the Mayor of the Village of Bellevue is authorized and directed to publish in the Peoria Journal Star once each week for three successive weeks, notice of the Village of Bellevue's intent to receive bids for the proposed sale of its water distribution system, above described.

SECTION 5. That sealed bids will be accepted by the Mayor of the Village of Bellevue, commencing September 29, 1973, and that any and all bids received to purchase the said water distribution system shall be opened at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, to be held for that purpose upon October 29, 1973, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. in the Village Hall, the usual place for meetings of the Village Board.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, has been negotiating with Peoria Water Company, for the sale by the Village of its water distribution system, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees have received an offer from the Peoria Water Company of a sum deemed to the best interest of the Village to sell its water system.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Bellevue, sell to Peoria Water Company, a public utility, its water distribution system, mains, reservoir, pumps, valves, hydrants, together with right-of-way where the same is now installed, for the sum of \$175,000.00, cash.

SECTION 2. That said Village shall retain accounts receivable, cash on hand and collect accounts up to September 1, 1973, and thereafter, Peoria Water Company will be the sole operator of the water system in this Village and territory served by it, reserving, however, the shut-off of customers of the Village who do not pay the bills owed to the Village up to said ~~September 1~~, 1973.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized and directed to sign on behalf of this Village, the Purchase Agreement with said Peoria Water Company, setting forth all of the terms and conditions of the sale, which said Agreement is hereunto attached and made a part hereof.
