

ORDINANCE 234

WHEREAS, the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois has been negotiating with Peoria Water Company, an Illinois corporation, for the sale by the Village of all personal property owned by the Village and used to maintain its water distribution system, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deems that it is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the Village to hold and maintain said personal property used in its water distribution system.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Bellevue sell to the Peoria Water Company, a public utility, all the personal property consisting in and embraced by its water distribution system, including, but not limited to: mains, reservoir, pumps, valves and hydrants, where the same are now installed for the sum of \$1.00 and other valuable consideration

SECTION 2. That said Village shall retain accounts receivable, cash on hand and collect accounts up to November 1, 1973, and thereafter, Peoria Water Company will be the sole operator of the water system in this Village and territory served by it, reserving, however, the shut-off of customers of the Village who do not pay the bills owed to the Village up to said November 1, 1973.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized and directed to sign on behalf of this Village, a Bill of Sale with said Peoria Water Company, setting forth all of the terms and conditions of the sale, which said Bill of Sale is hereunto attached and made a part hereof.

NOTICE OF SALE OF THE VILLAGE OF
BELLEVUE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

Notice is given that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, by ordinance duly passed and adopted on September 29, 1973, pursuant to authority of Chapter 24, Section 11-76-2, Illinois Revised Statutes, offer for sale to all interested purchasers all easements, rights of way and other interests in the real estate comprising its water distribution system located in the Village of Bellevue and used to operate and lawfully maintain its water distribution system.

Interested persons may examine at the office of the Village Clerk of the Village of Bellevue, 182 Byron Ct., Bellevue, Illinois, between the hours of the legal descriptions of the easements, rights of way and other interests in the real estate and system heretofore described, and upon acceptance of any offer, the Village will provide merchantable title to real estate, grant rights in easements and legal instruments for all other easements, interests and appurtenances.

Sealed bids may be submitted to the Mayor of the Village of Bellevue, after September 29, 1973. All bids will be opened at a regular session of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, upon October 29, 1973, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. The high bid or any other bid which is determined to be in the best interests of the Village which is approved by 3/4ths of the members authorized by law to hold the office on the Village Board, shall be accepted.
