AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN OBSOLETE ORDINANCE IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That certain ordinances of this Village are no longer applicable or pertain to the affairs of this Village and it is desired to remove them from the records, they being hereby repealed forthwith, as follows:


