AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE STORAGE OR DISPOSAL OF BRUSH, BRANCHES, WASTED OR USED LUMBER, CANES OR BOTTLES UPON ANY LOT IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AND PROVIDING FOR A FINE FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, it is deemed contrary to the welfare and health of this Village and detrimental to the ecology and community betterment to store, dispose of branches, waste or used lumber, tree limbs, grass or weed, car, cuttings likely to draw rats and other vermin.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to suffer or permit to be stored or disposed of, any brush, tree limbs, used lumber, waste lumber or building materials not being used, or to deposit or permit to be deposited or strewn of cans, bottles, piled grass or weed cuttings, upon any lot, tract or parcel owned by or under his control, for more than 14 days.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than Fifteen Dollars nor more than Five Hundred Dollars, for each offense and costs thereof.

SECTION 3. Nothing herein shall pertain to building materials being stored on the premises while actual remodeling or building is being conducted thereon pursuant to permit issued by the Village.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and due publication thereof according to law.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealed.
