

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING IN SCHOOL ZONE AT PLANK ROAD AND BELLEVUE AVENUE, IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:


SECTION 1. That the area designated as 100 feet on either side of the intersection of Plank Road and Bellevue Avenue, in the Village of Bellevue, is hereby declared to be a school crossing zone, and it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on either side of the street within 100 feet of the said intersection, or upon property within 10 feet of the shoulder of said intersection.

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$10.00, nor more than \$200.00 for each offense.

SECTION 3. The police are hereby authorized to cause the removal of any vehicle when so illegally parked, and any such vehicle so removed shall be impounded until the towing charges and storage costs have been paid. This shall be in addition to the fine heretofore provided.


SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealed.
