ORDINANCE NO. 245

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING THE CORPORATE TAX FOR THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1975 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1976.

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Appropriation ordinance was duly passed and adopted upon August 12, 1975, making appropriation of funds necessary for the corporate purposes of this Village, and now more than ten days have passed since its publication in the Peoria Journal-Star upon August 15, 1975, and

WHEREAS, it is now the duty of the Village Board to determine the amount necessary for the corporate expenses to be levied for such purposes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the following sum or sums of money, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, are deemed necessary to meet the necessary corporate purposes and expenses of the Village of Bellevue, and the same are hereby levied against all properties that are subject to taxation in this municipality in order to raise the sum of \$22,275.00, for general fund, plus Special fund levies hereinafter set forth, as follows:

SECTION 3. The Village Clerk is directed to file a duly certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of Peoria County, Illinois, within the time and manner as provided for by Law.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided for by Law.




