

ORDINANCE NO. 248

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PEORIA WATER COMPANY TO INSTALL WATER MAINS IN STARR LANE, IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN SAID WATER COMPANY AND THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the area including Starr Lane has been annexed to the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, by Ordinance duly passed and adopted upon July 23, 1974, and

WHEREAS, said annexed area and Lane is not now served with municipal water service and the wells therein are contaminated; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement between the Village of Bellevue on the sale of the municipal water system, required that the said Peoria Water Co., shall upon passage of an Ordinance to serve any annexed area with water mains and service, and

WHEREAS, though often requested and reminded so to do, the said Peoria Water Company has refused and neglected to serve the said residents of Starr Lane with any water service.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That PEORIA WATER COMPANY, be and it is hereby notified and directed to forthwith serve the area and lane known as Starr Lane with water service as a part of the water system serving this municipality, within 60 days of this date;


SECTION 2. That the attached plat indicating the area and Lane herunto made a part hereof, was annexed as of July 23, 1974, and is to be served by said Water Company, pursuant to their agreement with this Village.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, in manner as provided for by law.

SECTION 4. That the Village Clerk shall forthwith send by Registered mail, a duly Certified copy of this Ordinance to the Peoria Water Company.


