

ORDINANCE NO. 251

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF A TAX ANNUALLY OF NOT TO EXCEED .075% OF THE VALUE, AS EQUALIZED OR ASSESSED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS, TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR THE PURPOSE OF POLICE PROTECTION IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, WHICH TAX SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO AND IN EXCESS OF ALL OTHER TAXES AUTHORIZED TO BE LEVIED FOR GENERAL PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the corporate authorities of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, may levy, annually, a tax of not to exceed .075% of the value, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Local Government Affairs, of all taxable property therein, to provide revenue for the purpose of police protection in said municipality; provided said municipality shall not levy to exceed .05% for the first year it levies for such purposes and not to exceed an additional .025% in a succeeding year. This tax shall be in addition to and in excess of all taxes authorized by law to be levied and collected in this Village and shall be in addition to and in excess of the amount authorized to be levied for general purposes as provided for by Section 8-3-1.


SECTION 2. The authority for this additional tax is taken pursuant to Chapter 24, Paragraph 11-1-3, Illinois Revised Statutes of 1975, as amended.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and due publication, and the same shall be published instanter by the Village Clerk my making the same available forthwith in book or pamphlet form, as provided for by statutes.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are as to such conflict, hereby repealed.
