

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE UNIFORM SYSTEM OF HOUSE NUMBERING AND STREET NAMING AS PREPARED BY THE COUNTY OF PEORIA, AS THE SAME APPLIES TO THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, AND PROVIDING A FINE FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established a uniform system of numbering all houses and buildings, now constructed or hereafter constructed, fronting on all streets, avenues and highways in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, the map showing all lots and streets in this Village with the numbering system is hereunto attached and expressly made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The numbering system is designed by Peoria County on the grid system, to facilitate all mailings and emergency services for the welfare and safety of the residents in this County. All odd numbers are on the north and the west side of a street, and all even numbers are on south and east side of such streets.

SECTION 3. It shall be the duty of anyone laying out a new area or subdivision to prepare and submit a house numbering grid that satisfies the County master system, to the proper County officer.

SECTION 4. When properly notified in writing, it shall be the duty of the owners or occupants of any house or building to display in a location readily visible from the street or public highway, numbers at least two and one-half inches high, and not to exceed six inches high the assigned number for that house or building. Buildings which carry numbers shall retain both the old and new numbers until March 1, 1980, and thereafter the old numbers shall be removed.

SECTION 5. The street names and designations on the attached plat shall be used for all addressing purposes.

SECTION 6. The enforcement officer of this Village shall be in charge of maps and the enforcement of the system of numbering within the village, and shall assist in problems thereof.

SECTION 7. Any person, firm or corporation violating or failing to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$15.00, nor more than \$200.00, for each day any such violation continues.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall take priority over any other ordinance on the subject, and it shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage in pamphlet form and the same having been prepared in pamphlet form by the Village Clerk, is henceforth in full force and effect.

ORDINANCE NO. 263

SECTION 1.
