

ORDINANCE NO. 264

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SPEED LIMIT FOR VEHICLES IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AND PROVIDING A FINE FOR THE VIOLATION OF SUCH SPEED LIMIT.

Whereas, a survey has been conducted of the streets, conditions and factors to determine the speed at which motor vehicles can safely travel the streets of this Village, including the fact that children are not provided with sidewalks, and the determination of the speed to be allowed for such vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

1. That it shall be unlawful to drive or operate any motor vehicle upon any street in the Village of Bellevue, at a greater speed than twenty-five (25) miles per hour, other than on State Highways.
2. That any person who operates any motor vehicle at a speed greater than the limits herein set, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$15.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offence.
3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are, as to such conflict, hereby repealed and the same shall be construed together with other ordinances on the subject.
4. On State and Federally sponsored highways, the maximum speed shall be that established by the State of Illinois.
5. That the Commissioner of streets shall post or cause to be posted the speed limit in areas wherein this ordinance applies.
6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and the posting of speed limits, as aforesaid, and this ordinance shall be published by the Village Clerk in pamphlet form and the same having been prepared, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect.
