## ORDINANCE NO. 265

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 45 AS TO SECTION 1, OF SAID ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL LIGHNSE CLASSIFICATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 45, dated March 26, 1946, be amended as to its Section 1, of said Ordinance No. 45, by adding the following sub-paragraphs thereto:

- There is hereby created an additional license 1. (b) classification designed as a Class "M", license, for uge in and on the premises of a Motel or Hotel, for the serving, furnishing or sale of alcoholic liquors, beers, wines, malt beverages and those incidentals thereto. The "M" licenses shall be limited to two (2) in number and the license fee shall be Six hundred dollars per year, payable quarterly.
  - (c). There is hereby created an additional license clagsification designated as a Class "W", license, for use in the premises for the serving or furnishing of wire and beer by the glass or mug, only with with and along with the serving of food to be esten in the premises. The "W" license shall be limited to one (1) in number and the license fee shell be Three hundred forty dollars per year, payable quarterly.

SECTION 2. All license classifications may be open during the usual hours established by the ordinances of this Villege, including days of elections.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in pamphlet form, and being so prepared and published, it is in effect instanter.

SECTION 4. All ordinances in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealled, otherwise said ordinance shall be construid together as hereby amended.
