ORDINANCE NO. 266

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PART OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 8 NORTH, RANGE 7 EAST OF THE 4th PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, TO THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE (GENOVESE PROPERTY)

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the Village Board, a written Petition, duly verified, for the annexation of the property of JOHN M. GENOVESE, JR. and GLORIA J. GENOVESE, to the Village of Bellevue, and

WHEREAS, said petitioners are the owners of record of all of the tract or parcel of land sought by them to be annexed, and they have represented, under oath, that there are no electors residing thereon; and

WHEREAS, the said parcel or tract of land is a compact parcel, with the south line thereof (the front) also being the north line of the boundary of the Village of Bellevue, at said point, and

WHEREAS, it is now the duty of the corporate authorities to consider the question of the annexation, since the said described parcel is not presently within the corporate limits of any other municipality.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the following tract or parcel of land, described as:

A part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian, situated and being in the County of Peoria and State of Illinois, more fully described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the North line of State Route 116 and a line 280 feet East and parallel to the West line of said Southeast Quarter, as the place of beginning;
thence North, 89° 37' East along the North line of said State Route No. 116, a distance of 92.98 feet to a pipe;
thence North a distance of 143 feet to a pipe;
thence West a distance of 92 feet, to a pipe;
thence South 156.53 feet, to the place of beginning,

be and the same is hereby annexed to a made a part of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, and the same is hereby incorporated within the corporate limits of this Village.

SECTION 2. That the Plat hereunto attached and expressly made a part hereof, is a true, correct and accurate plat or map of said territory hereby annexed and it correctly shows its relation to the existing boundaries of this Village.

SECTION 3. That the Village Clerk shall forthwith cause publication of this ordinance in pamphlet form, and the same having been so published, is now in full forth and effect; the said Village Clerk shall also file Certified copies hereof, with a copy of the map, with the Recorder of Deeds and the County Clerk of Peoria County, Illinois, and such other agencies as may be entitled to such copies and plats.

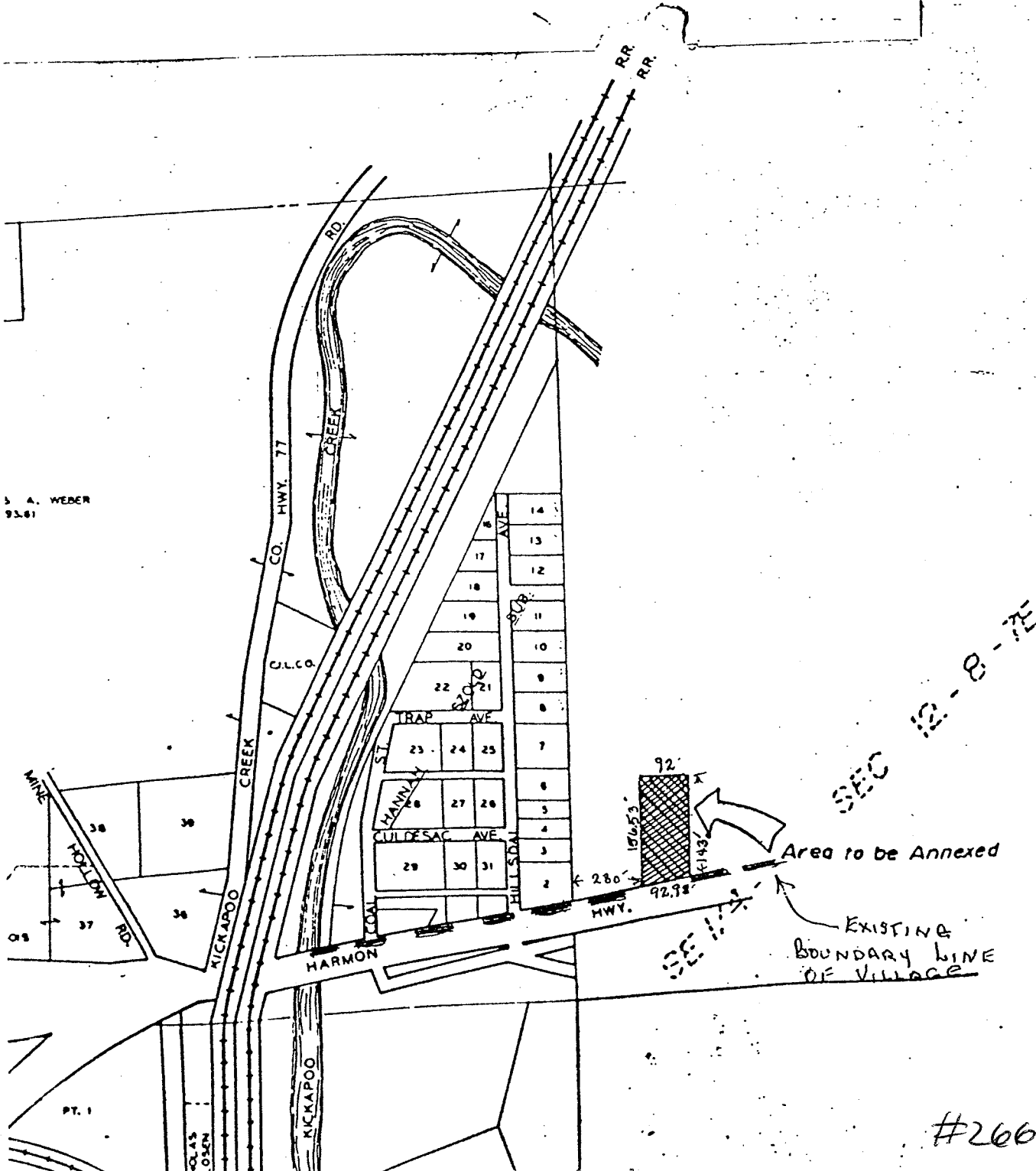

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION TO THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

To the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois:

The undersigned owners of record of all land within the territory herein described, and by at least _____ percent of the electors residing thereon, respectfully state that they desire to be annexed to and made a part of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, and state:

1. That the described territory is not within the corporate limits of any municipality, but that it is contiguous to the existing limits of the Village of Bellevue;
2. That the territory has *No* electors residing thereon
3. That your Petitioners request the annexation of said territory, described as, to-wit:

A part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 8 North, Range 7 East of the 4th Principal Meridian, situated and being in the County of Peoria and State of Illinois, further described as follows:

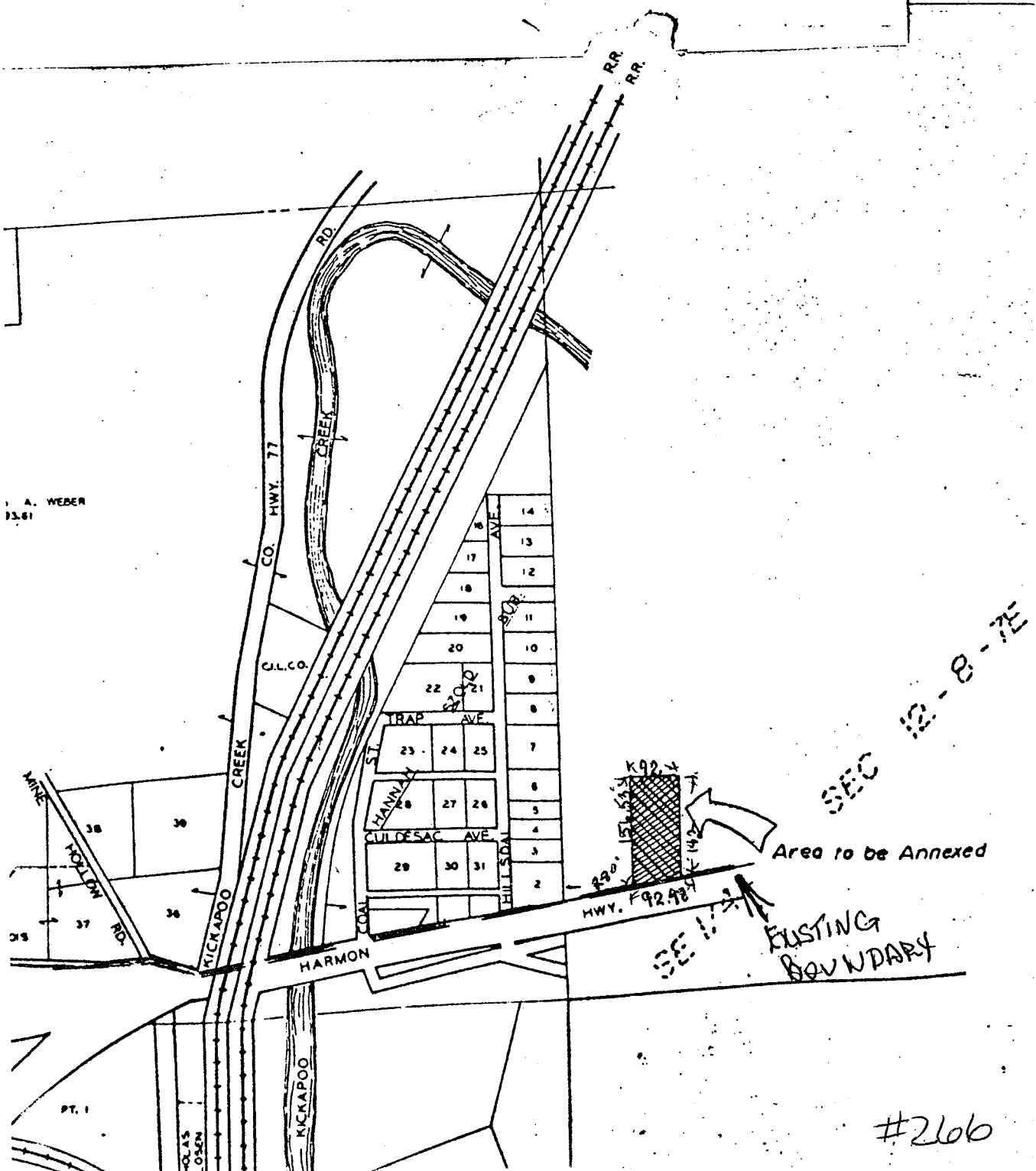

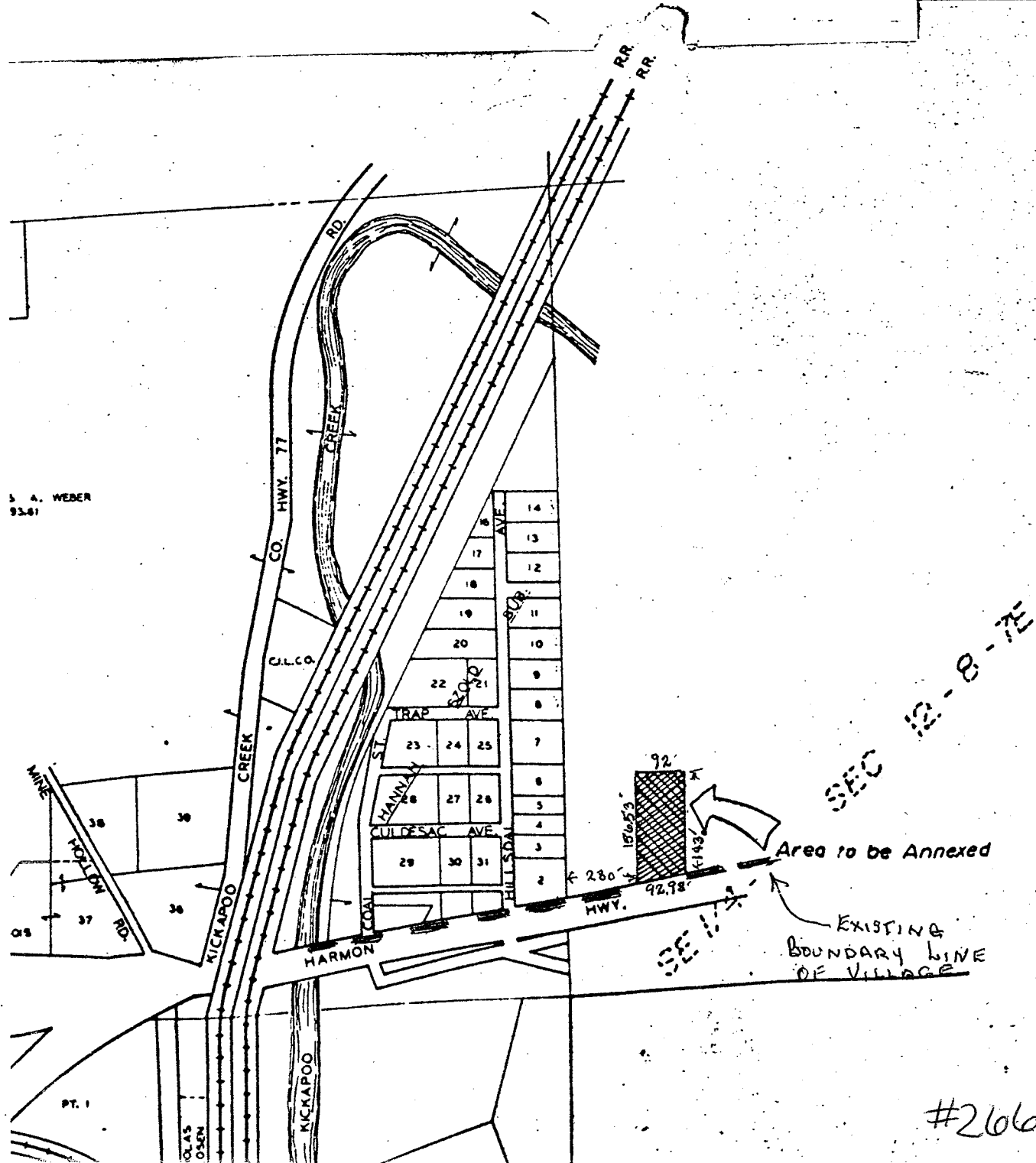
