

ORDINANCE NO. 273

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OR STOPPING OF VEHICLES WITHIN TEN FEET OF THE PAVED OR TRAVELLED SURFACE OF ANY STATE OR FEDERAL DESIGNATED HIGHWAY IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AND PROVIDING A FINE FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to stop or park any vehicle so that any part thereof, is within ten feet of the paved or traveled portion of any State or Interstate designated highway in or through the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois.

SECTION 2. Any vehicle stopped or parked in violation of this ordinance, may be removed by any police officer and impounded until both the towing and storage charges have been paid.

SECTION 3. Any person found guilty of the violation of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than twenty dollars nor more than five hundred dollars, and any storage or towing shall be included in such fine so assessed, if any.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided for by law, and any conflict with other ordinances, this ordinance shall govern. However, should any part be determined to be void by a Court, that portion, only, shall be eliminated and otherwise the remainder of this ordinance shall stand in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form, and it being so published, shall be in full force upon its passage.
