

ORDINANCE NO. 277

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING THE CORPORATE TAX FOR THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1981 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1982.

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year was fully passed and adopted upon August 11, 1981, after a public hearing held thereon for which due notices were given for more than 10 days, and now more than ten days having passed since the adoption and publication of said ordinance, it is the duty of the President and Board of Trustees of this Village to adopt the Annual Tax Levy for said Village of Bellevue, to meet the necessary corporate purposes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the following sum or sums, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, be and the same are hereby levied against all of the properties that are subject to taxation in this Village of Bellevue, in order to raise the amounts levied for the General Fund, the Special Funds and the various funds hereby levied, as follows:

SECTION 2. That the amounts levied hereby have been adjusted to deduct anticipated receipts from various sources, including the corporate replacement taxes, licenses and fines, etc., anticipated to be received.

SECTION 3. That the total amount of the tax levy is less than 105% of the amount of property taxes extended upon the levy of the preceeding year.

SECTION 4. That the County Clerk is hereby directed to extend a tax on the taxable property in the Village of Bellevue, to produce an amount as set forth in this tax levy, according to HB 1048, current laws.

SECTION 5. The Village Clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this tax levy with the County Clerk on or before the second Tuesday in Sept. of the currect calendar year.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, and the approval thereof by the Village President.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, hereby repealed.
