AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 52, BY  
ADDING TO PARAGRAPH 3 THEREOF, SUB-PARAGRAPH  
(a) PROVIDING FOR AN ARCADE LICENSE UNDER  
CONDITIONS, IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE,  
IN PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

SECTION 1. That Paragraph 3 of Ordinance No. 52 is amended by  
the addition thereto of a Subparagraph (a), which shall read as  
follows:

(a) In the event that any owner, operator has more than 10  
coin operated machines or devices, the maximum fee for  
ten or more machines, but not more than 30 machines, shall  
be \$250.00. However, in any tavern or other premises where  
said machines are located, they shall be separated and kept  
in a separate room where no liquor or intoxicating beer or  
beverage is served or permitted to be taken or consumed in  
that area where the machines are offered for use by the public.


SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances shall remain in  
full force and effect, except as amended or changed, and all shall  
be construed together.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and  
after its passage and approved by the Board and Village President, in  
manner as provided by law, and the same being published in pamphlet form,  
is in effect immediately this date.
