

ORDINANCE NO. 281

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LIQUOR CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, TO PROVIDE FOR TWO LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS WITH FEES AND REVOKING ONLY THOSE ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE SUBJECT COVERED HEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINCE BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 256 is hereby repealed and in its place, this ordinance shall govern.

SECTION 2. Effective October 1, 1982, there shall be not more than four (4) CLASS "A" licenses issued in effect in the Village of Bellevue. The license fee for such license shall be \$200.00 per quarter. All Class "A" licensed taverns shall close promptly and be vacated of all patrons by the hour of 2:00 o'clock A.M. and shall remain closed and clear of patrons until the hour of 6:00 o'clock A.M. each day of the week, EXCEPT Sundays, when such tavern shall remain closed until the hour of 9:00 o'clock A.M.

SECTION 3. Effective October 1, 1982, there shall be not more than three (3) CLASS "B" tavern licenses issued in the Village of Bellevue. The license fee for such license shall be \$250.00 per quarter. All class "B" licensed taverns shall close promptly and be vacated of all patrons by the hour of 2:00 o'clock A.M. Monday through Friday, and by 4:00 o'clock A.M. on Saturday and Sunday, and shall remain closed of all patrons until the hour of 6:00 o'clock A.M. all days, except Sundays, when such tavern shall remain closed until the hour of 9:00 o'clock A.M.

SECTION 4. All CLASS "B" licenses are issued only for two quarters of the year, terminatine April 1, 1983, unless otherwise extended by the Board of Trustees of this Village.

SECTION 5. All license fees are due before the beginning of the quarter for which they are to be issued and any licensee who fails to pay prior to the beginning of the quarter, shall automatically have the license cancelled and not re-issued until re-applied for and granted not sooner than three days.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance revokes all portions of ordinances in conflict herewith and shall be otherwise construed with such other ordinances on the subject.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law, and being directed to be published in pamphley form, shall be in full force and effect as soon as it is so published.
