

ORDINANCE NO. 289

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING THE CORPORATE TAX FOR THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1984, AND ENDING ON JUNE 30, 1985

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year was duly passed and adopted upon August 28, 1984, after a public hearing held thereon for which due notice was given for more than 10 days prior thereto, and now more than 10 days have elapsed since the adoption and publication of said Ordinance, it is now the duty of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, to adopt the Annual Tax Levy for said Village of Bellevue, to meet and defray the necessary corporate expenses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the following sum or sums, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, be and the same are hereby levied and assessed against all of the properties that are subject to taxation in the Village of Bellevue, in order to raise the amount levied for the General Fund and the Special Funds and the various funds levied, as follows:

SECTION 2. That the various amounts herein levied have been adjusted after deducting the anticipated receipts from various sources, including the Corporate Replacement receipts, License fees, Fines and other revenues likely to be received.

SECTION 3. That the total amount of the tax herein levied is less than 105% of the amount levied or extended on the levy of the preceding year, according to statutes in such case provided.

SECTION 4. The County Clerk is hereby directed to extend a tax on all taxable property in this municipality subject to taxation, to produce the amounts set forth in this levy according to HB 1048.

SECTION 5. The Village Clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance levying the municipal tax, with the County Clerk of Peoria County, on or before the second Tuesday of September of this current year.

SECTION 6. -This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption by the Board of Trustees, and the approval thereof by the President of the Board.

SECTION 7. All ordinances of parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, repealed.
