Board Members, discussed property sale, off Harmon Hwy, to I.D.O.T. Property location needed, for future bridge improvements, on Harmon Hwy. Discussed was location, purpose of use, also, if property was needed, for Village use. Conclusion was State would inevitably acquire property. Board was unanimously, in favor, of selling property.

**Speaker- Peoria County Officer, Ferguson** - Informed the Board that Peoria County Sheriffs Dept., has apprehended the assailants that burglarized local bar. Advised anyone that witnesses suspicious activity, to call police. Officer Ferguson, made aware that U.P.S., has experienced packages being stolen, from resident's front porches.

**Speaker- Pat Prather** – Approached Board Members, about rezoning his property located, off Plank Rd. Mr. Prather would like to have property rezoned from residential to commercial property. Village Attorney, suggested filing petition, with detail, legal description, to Zoning Commission. Upon Zoning Commission approval, the Board, with all information needed would address rezoning property. Mr. Prather inquired, about if TIF money was available, to help with possible road construction. Chairman Johnson, communicated that TIF was apportioned, at present time, to other improvement projects.

**Speaker- Nancy Crew** – Expressed concerns, about road use and condition, of N. Bellevue Ave.

**Speaker- Brian Stuffelbeam-** Expressed, to Members and residents, that he thought the Village and Police Dept., have been doing a good job.

**Speaker- Superintendent, Wilson** –Spoke, with Jim Lancaster, resident and owner, of turn around, at end of Ridgeview Ln. Mr. Lancaster, would like the Village of Bellevue, to purchase the turn around.
