Speaker, Resident, Mike Raker – Enlightened the Board Members, about a neighbor located @ 5406 Closen Rd., that has built a dirt track, for ATV, riding. Mr. Raker, stated that the home is a rental home and renters, are riding ATV's, around the dirt track. Mr. Raker, stated he has spoken with renter and tenants are not willing, to stop disrupting other neighbors. Mr. Raker, would like an Ordinance, adopted that would stop ATV, riding in yards. **Other neighbors**, attending the meeting, shared their concerns. New neighbor **Laurel**, on Main St., moved to Bellevue, for a better life. Laurel, does not appreciate noise, after 9 p.m. Main St., resident, **Scott Raker**, is concerned, about property value when selling his home. **Jane**, resident on Main St., said she could hear ATV's, even when house is closed up.

Chairman, Johnson – Inquired as to if residents have called the owner/landlord, to notify of situation? Chairman Johnson advised that the Village Attorney, would look into situation possibly as a general nuisance. Chairman, Johnson, stated the Village, would have something addressing the matter, by next meeting.

Speaker, Gary Byerline – Spoke of business close to him burning for four nights and is filling in water retention area.

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Trustee, Lannert – Inquired on progress of burned house, on Anna St?

Attorney, Alster - Informed that burned house on Anna St., will be addressed in July, along with the Closen Rd., house.
