The Village Council, of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, met in Regular Session March 26, 2019. Chairman Johnson, called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

Mr. Pedigo, inquired as to what are the guidelines, to operate a facility?

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Chairman Johnson – Explained other establishments have food and liquor, and sells have to be equal on each. Chairman Johnson, explained Liquor License class, depends, upon what Board Members, approve. A bar/tavern is \$600.00 a year. Chairman Johnson, stated more information needed to be checked on and would-be put-on April 9, 2019, Agenda.

Trustee, Lannert – Asked if more flags were needed this year for the Village? Trustee, Lannert, informed the Board, flags were on sale again this year.

Superintendent, Wilson – Advised the Board, that a few more flags were needed.

Trustee, Heskett – Informed the Board and Officer, Ferguson, that people are running stop signs on Katherine St.

Officer, Ferguson – Informed he would watch and stated he has dealt with some of the people already.
