

ORDINANCE NO. 322

AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS,  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1988,  
AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1989

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the Board of Trustees to make the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the Village of Bellevue, in the first quarter of the fiscal year, which has been fixed as beginning July 1, 1988 and ending June 30, 1989, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined the various amounts to be budgeted and appropriated to meet the necessary corporate purposes of this Village for said fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance in tentative form has been prepared and made conveniently available for public inspection for upwards of ten days, and a public hearing was held after a published notice was duly given on July 16, 1988, all according to law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1.** That the Village of Bellevue's estimated revenue for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1989, is as follows:
