AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING THE CORPORATE TAX
FOR THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1988,
AND ENDING ON JUNE 30, 1989

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY,
ILLINOIS:



SECTION 5. The Village Clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance levying the municipal tax, with the County of this current year.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption by the Board of Trustees, and the approval thereof by the President of the Board.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, as to such conflict, repealed.







CERTIFICATION OF ORDINANCE


