

Ordinance No. 327 PASSED 5-0

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING
ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE

WHEREAS, the Village of Bellevue Zoning Board ("Zoning Board") published notice of a public hearing with regard to an amendment to the Village Zoning Ordinance to increase the number of members of the Zoning Board of Appeals from five to seven;

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board held a public hearing with regard to such amendment;

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board has recommended to the Village of Bellevue Board of Trustees that the Zoning Ordinance be so amended; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Village of Bellevue that the Zoning Ordinance is so amended,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the zoning ordinance of the Village of Bellevue is hereby amended by deleting Section 14.1 thereof in its entirety and substituting therefor the following paragraph:

Section 14.1

A Zoning Board of Appeals, hereinafter referred to by the term (Zoning Board), is hereby authorized to be established. Such Zoning Board shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the members of the Village Board of Trustees. The seven members of the first Zoning Board appointed shall serve terms of one, two, three, four, five, six and seven years respectively. Thereafter, as terms expire, each appointment shall be for five years. Vacancies shall be filled by the Mayor of the Village Board for the unexpired terms only, subject to confirmation by the Village Board at its next meeting. The Village Board shall have power to remove any member of the Zoning Board for cause, after a public hearing upon giving ten days notice thereof.

Section 2. That all actions of the Zoning Board of Appeals prior to this Ordinance are hereby ratified and approved.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect three (3) days from the date of its passage and approval.
