

ORDINANCE NO. 351

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING

WHEREAS, various businesses within the Village permit the parking of automobiles on private property adjoining Plank Road; and

WHEREAS, such parking near Plank Road makes it difficult for motorists entering Plank Road to see oncoming traffic on Plank Road, creating both a nuisance and a safety hazard; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code provides that the corporate authorities of a municipality may regulate the use of streets; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-60-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code provides that municipalities may define, prevent and abate nuisances;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Board of Trustees finds as fact the recitals set forth above.

Section 2: Parking of automobiles and other motor vehicles within ten (10) feet of the edge of the paved surface of any portion of Plank Road within the Village is hereby prohibited at all times.

Section 3: Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200). Each day that a vehicle is parked in violation of Section 2 hereof shall be considered a separate violations.

Section 4: In addition to the penalty provided in Section 3 hereof, any vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance may be towed upon fulfillment of the notice and hearing requirements of Village of Bellevue Ordinance No. 321.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
