

ORDINANCE NO. 407

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT
FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY
BY THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and necessary for the welfare of the residents of the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois to provide for the purchase of a new Sweepster Model HB60 hydraulic drive pickup sweeper with front caster wheel, 15 cu.ft. hopper, gutter brush, mounts on front of prime mover, sprinkler systems (the "Sweeper") to be used for the public purposes of the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 61-3 of Article 11 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village is authorized to lease and purchase real and personal property for public purposes pursuant to contracts which provide for the consideration for such transactions to be paid in annual installments during a period not exceeding 10 years; and

WHEREAS, Martin Equipment of Illinois, Inc. (the "Seller") has agreed to sell to the Village the Sweeper for a purchase price of \$3,645.00, payable in a single installment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: It is hereby determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the public interest that the Village purchase for public purposes the Sweeper, pursuant to an agreement between the

Village and the Seller providing for the purchase of the vehicle for a purchase price of \$3,645.00, payable in a single installment due upon delivery of the vehicle.

Section Two: The purchase agreement described in the preceding Section is hereby approved.

Section Three: From and after the effective date of this ordinance, the President and Clerk of the Village are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary and essential, including the execution of any documents and certificates, necessary to carry out the provisions of said agreement.
