

ORDINANCE NO. 433

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 293  
(LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE)

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees passed An Ordinance Relating to the Possession, Purchase, Dispensing or Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor in the Village of Bellevue, Peoria County, Illinois, Ordinance No. 293, on March 26, 1985, such Ordinance regulating all aspects of the sale of alcoholic liquor within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.1 of the Illinois Liquor Control Act (235 ILCS 5/4.1) provides that municipalities may establish regulations and restrictions on the operations under local licenses as the public good and convenience may require; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has determined that the best interest of the Village will be served if adult uses are prohibited in liquor establishments within the Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 2.9(a) of Ordinance No. 293 is hereby deleted in its entirety, and the following section is hereby substituted in its place:

(a) A subclass (1) license shall authorize the performance of live entertainment on the premises licensed pursuant to this Ordinance; provided, however, that any live entertainment must comply with Section 3.3 of this Ordinance.

Section 2: The following Section 3.3 is hereby added to Village of Bellevue Ordinance No. 293:

3.3 Adult Uses.

No adult uses shall be permitted on any premises licensed under this Ordinance. For purposes of this Section 3.3, "Adult Uses" shall mean those uses described in Article 23 of Village of Bellevue Ordinance No. 341, as amended by Ordinance No. 410.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be effective as of the date of its passage.
