

ORDINANCE NO. 434
VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS
ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING

WHEREAS, various streets within the Village of Bellevue are narrow; and

WHEREAS, when automobiles and other motor vehicles are parked on said streets, it becomes difficult to drive, turn around, back out of driveways and otherwise use said streets; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-2) provides that the corporate authorities of a municipality may regulate the use of streets; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the residents of the Village of Bellevue that parking be prohibited on certain streets within the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Board of Trustees finds as fact the recitals set forth above.

Section 2: Parking of automobiles or other motor vehicles on the following streets is hereby prohibited at all times:

- Deluxe Boulevard.

Section 3: Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200). Each day that a vehicle is parked on any of the streets listed in Section 2 hereof shall be considered a separate violations.

Section 4: In addition to the penalty provided in Section 3 hereof, any vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance may be towed upon fulfillment of the notice and hearing requirements of Village of Bellevue Ordinance No. 321.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall become effective within thirty (30) days of its passage.
