

ORDINANCE NO. 448

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC

(Four Way Stop: Closen & Main)

WHEREAS, Section 11-208 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208) provides that the corporate authorities of a municipality may adopt traffic regulations as provided herein; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Village Board of Trustees that the intersection of Main Street and Closen Road is a potential traffic hazard; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the residents of the Village that traffic be required to stop before proceeding through this intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Board of Trustees hereby finds as fact the recitals set forth above.

Section 2: The intersection of Main Street and Closen Road shall be a four way stop, and that all traffic shall be required to stop before proceeding through the intersection.

Section 3: The Board hereby authorizes and directs the Street Superintendent of the Village take all steps necessary and proper to carry out the intent of this ordinance, including without limitation the placing of appropriate stop signs at said intersection.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the placing of stop signs at said intersection.
