

ORDINANCE NO. 466

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS
ORDINANCE DEFINING NUISANCE
(BARKING DOGS)

WHEREAS, Section 11-60-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-60-2) authorizes the corporate authorities of each municipality to define, prevent and abate nuisances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue (the "Village") has determined that dogs or other animals that bark or make other noises, to the extent that they are audible off of the premises upon which they are kept, are a nuisance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The Village Board of Trustees hereby determines that any dog or other animal barking or making noise, to the extent audible off of the premises upon which they are kept, is a nuisance.

Section 2. Prohibition. No person shall allow a dog or other animal under his or her control to bark or make noise, to the extent audible off of the premises upon which the dog or other animal is kept.

Section 3. Fine. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage as provided by law.
