

ORDINANCE NO. 564

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING UNATTENDED VEHICLES CONTAINING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS IN ANY GENERAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT OR WITHIN FIVE HUNDRED (500) FEET OF ANY GENERAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, IN THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellevue (the "Village") has determined that it is dangerous for vehicles containing hazardous materials to be left unattended in any General Residential District or within five hundred (500) feet of any General Residential District, and

WHEREAS, Section 11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code authorizes municipalities to regulate the use of streets;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful to leave unattended any vehicle containing hazardous materials, including but not limited to any explosive, flammable, or other highly combustible materials or radioactive materials, within any General Residential District as indicated upon the zoning map of the Village of Bellevue, Illinois, pursuant to Ordinance No. 553, or within five hundred (500) feet of any General Residential District.

SECTION 2. That any persons, firms or corporations, or agents, employees or contractors of such, who violate, disobey, omit, neglect or refuse to comply with or who resist enforcement of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than \$750. Each day that a violation continues shall be considered a separate offense.


SECTION 3. That the police are hereby authorized to cause the removal of any vehicle left unattended in violation of this Ordinance, and any such vehicle so removed shall be impounded until the towing charges and storage costs have been paid. This shall be in addition to the fine heretofore provided.


SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after it is published as provided by law.
