

ORDINANCE NO. 701

VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, ILLINOIS

ORDINANCE REGARDING PREVAILING WAGE

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted the Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/1, *et seq.*) (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the Village of Bellevue (the "Village") investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in the Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of the Village employed in performing construction of public works for the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE:

Section 1: To the extent and as required by the Act, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Peoria County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June of the current year, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by the Act, all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Village. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in the Act shall be the same as in the Act.

Section 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Village to the extent required by the Act.

Section 3: The Clerk of the Village shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Village this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wages. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

Section 4: The Clerk of the Village shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association or employees who have filed their name and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 5: The Clerk of the Village shall promptly file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Illinois Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

Section 6: The Clerk of the Village shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of the Village.
